
A LANDMARK OF BOX HILL








Afforded with grand stone tiling, Prospect's bathrooms make for the perfect place to prepare or unwind – functionality and convenience exemplified.






5 Artist Impression of Penthouse Terrace




PROSPEROUS PLENTIFUL PEACEFUL

BUZZING WITH A WEALTH OF DINING DESTINATIONS




