


WELCOME TO THE NEIGHBOURHOOD

ALREADY WELL CONNECTED

Aurora is ideally positioned within the established Epping and Wollert neighbourhoods 25km north of Melbourne's CBD, just south of Craigieburn Road East. With direct freeway access to Melbourne CBD or regional Victoria from the Hume Freeway, the new O'Herns Road interchange will cut travel time even further. And local industry is thriving at the Cooper Street employment precinct – just 4km away.

You also have the choice of two train stations today, South Morang and Epping, and the proposed Aurora Town Centre train station in the future. Established bus routes mean public transport is only ever a short walk away.

Aurora is also conserving one of Victoria's rarest native vegetations, Temperate Grassland, which has been long preserved by the Wurundjeri and Woiwurung peoples, the traditional custodians of the land.

Less than 1% of the state's native grasslands remain, so these areas are carefully managed to provide a habitat for local birds and endangered species.

This natural wonder is yours to enjoy from Aurora's trails and bike paths, with 14 conservation areas encompassing 25 hectares of native grasslands, rich with wildflowers and indigenous flora.

Their colours mark the changing seasons, from lush green in spring and summer to red and brown through the cooler months, connecting you with the natural cycle of the earth.
