






Tranquil Gardens

Passive Design

Sculpt prioritises passive features over active building systems, meaning the building relies predominantly on natural elements for temperature regulation as opposed to mechanical systems.

Solar Panels

Experience low-carbon living with a 10 kW Solar PV system on the rooftop, generating onsite renewable energy. Sculpt exceeds energy efficiency standards with a minimum 6.5 Star NatHERS rating, showcasing an outstanding commitment to a sustainable future.

Electric Car Charging

The garage at Sculpt includes infrastructure for AC electric vehicle charging. Residents can also access the nearby Tesla Supercharger for fast and convenient charging, making sustainable transportation effortless.

Water Efficiency

Sculpt is designed for optimum water efficiency, with stormwater collection achieving 100% on the STORM rating tool. A 27kL in-ground rainwater tank also ensures responsible water use, from toilet flushing to lush garden irrigation.

Waste Management

The building reduces contribution to landfill through a comprehensive waste management system. From FOGO bins for food and garden waste to dual waste chute systems on every residential level, Sculpt aligns with best practice waste management.

Natural Light

Sculpt's residences are designed to harness an abundance of natural light, promoting energy savings and enhancing indoor environments.

Cross-Flow Ventilation






Glenferrie Road


Via Porta Bakehouse






Riversdale Rd Village

Stroll down to Renaissance for whatever it is you need – be it premium produce, pantry essentials, fine wines or French cheese.










Auburn Road


Grace Park

Home to a well-equipped sporting complex, expansive off-leash oval and charming wooden playground, Grace Park is the recreational heart of the Hawthorn community.


Central Gardens


